SPIDER BITE **FIRST AID**

What to do:

1. Check breathing and pulse
2. Calm the patient
3. Apply pressure with bandage and/or ice pack to bite area
4. Do not move patient
5. Call 000 for ambulance
6. If safe to do so, collect spider for identification

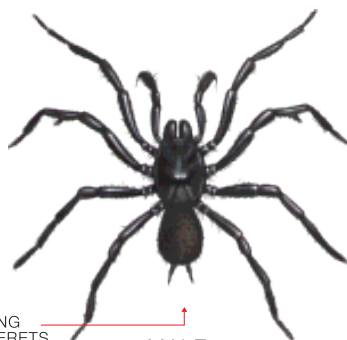

ENLARGED HEAD & FANGS • DEEP PAINFUL BITE
GROUND DWELLING - OFTEN MISTAKEN FOR FUNNEL-WEB



SMALL SPINNERETS

Common

BLACK HOUSE SPIDER

VENOMOUS, NAUSEA, SWEATING, ETC.

OFTEN FOUND IN THEIR WEBS IN WINDOW FRAMES, EAVES, ETC.



WOLF SPIDER

NON AGGRESSIVE
GROUND DWELLING

COMMON - LOW RISK



FEMALE

TRAP-DOOR

MILDLY TOXIC • NON AGGRESSIVE
GROUND DWELLING (BURROW - OFTEN WITHOUT A LID)



MALE

TRAP-DOOR



GARDEN ORB-WEAVING

RELATIVELY HARMLESS • BENEFICIAL
OFTEN SEEN IN A LARGE WEB IN THE GARDEN



SAINT ANDREW'S CROSS



HUNTSMAN

TIMID • RARELY BITES
FOUND UNDER LOOSE BARK
MAY WANDER INDOORS
